SOURCE B: Miniature out of the (Switzerland) of 1411. The disease shows the plague, although the location more consistent with smallpox.

The long term cause is the position of the planets. It is also caused by evil smells which mix with the air and spread on the wind. When you breathe in the corrupted air you catch the plague.
SOURCE C: Based on a report written by doctors at Paris University in 1348.

Some people thought that the cause were lumps in the skin, livid black spots on the face, neck, arms and thighs and other parts of the body. These were covered. Almost all died within a few days without any hope of recovery.

'In January of the year 1348, three Genoese ships arrived in Genoa. They had come from the East and were laden with the Plague. No one would go near them because they had a valuable cargo of spices and other goods.
