#### **Sixth Form Registration/GCSE Results Day – Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August**

GCSE results day is **Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August**. You can collect your results from **9am – 11am**. It is important you come in person to collect your results as the Sixth Form team will be available to speak to regarding your programme of study for September and register you for the Sixth Form. If you do not achieve the GCSE results you were hoping for, the Sixth Form team will be able to support you and give you the best advice moving forwards. **Sixth Form registration will run from 9am – 12pm.**

Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> August will also be Registration Day for external applicants wishing to apply for our Sixth Form. External applicants will need to bring with them their GCSE results printed from their school and a form of ID such as Passport or Birth Certificate. These will need to be brought in and completed by Thursday 29<sup>th</sup> August.

#### **Rising Y13's**

Y12 students that have sat external AS or BTEC exams in May/June will be able to collect their results on **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> August** at **8:15am – 10:30am**. I look forward to seeing smiling faces and celebrating your successes with you.

#### **September Times**
